On Tuesday, July 26, 2011, Cypress Mayor Leroy Mills, Council Member Douglas A. Bailey, and the City's BRACE Program team members toured the facilities of Tayco Engineering, Inc. and visited with Dr. Jay Chung, President and CEO and the Tayco team.

Tayco Engineering, Inc., founded by Mr. Charles Taylor in 1971, moved to the City of Cypress in 1991 from the City of Long Beach. The company boasts a workforce of 130 employees and 25 high-level engineers.

For the past 40 years, Tayco has produced high tech heaters, temperature sensors, and cables for various space programs. Major clients of the company include NASA, and spacecraft integrating companies such as The Boeing Company, Lockheed Martin, Loral, and Northrop Grumman. The Space Shuttle Program, Mars Rover, International Space Station, and many more space exploration programs have depended on Tayco's special development technique.

Dr. Chung and his team received the 2006 Exceptional Company Performance Award from the Boeing Company for their contribution to the International Space Station Program. This award recognized Tayco's outstanding support and critical role in providing electrical heaters and temperature sensors for the Hydrogen Vent Valve Assembly (HVVA) on the Space Station.

Tayco is noted for developing solutions to the issues that caused the accidents of Space Shuttles Challenger and Columbia. Two years after the Challenger accident, on September 30, 1988, Space Shuttle Discovery was launched successfully with a newly developed field joint protecting heating system by Tayco to keep the O-Rings warm even in cold weather.
