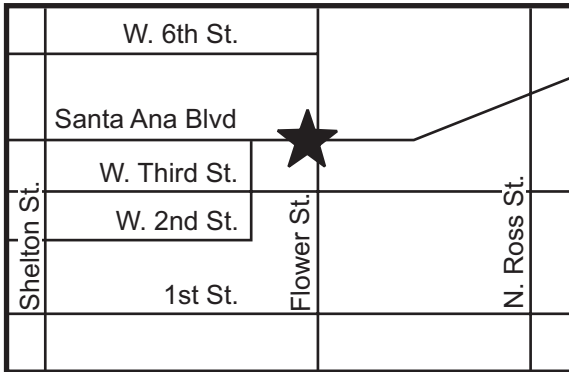

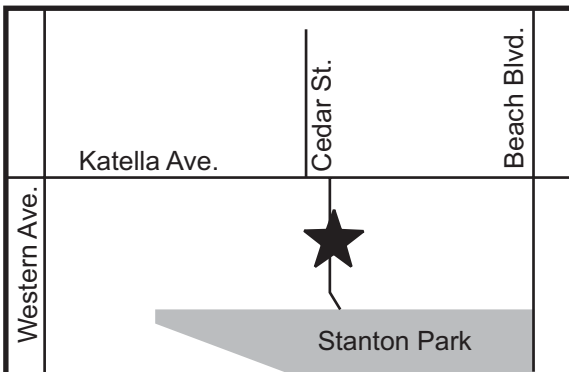

HOW TO OBTAIN SEX OFFENDER INFORMATION

MEGAN'S LAW

In 1996, California enacted "Megan's Law," which provides the public with photographs and descriptive information on serious sex offenders residing in California who have been convicted of committing sex crimes and are required to register their whereabouts with local law enforcement.

The release of this information to the public is a means of assuring public protection and not to punish the offender. The information may not be used to harass the offender or commit any crime against the offender. Public safety is best served when offenders are not concealing their location to avoid harassment.

The CD ROM provides the following information:

- registrant's name (including aliases)
- photograph (if available)
- sex
- physical description
- registered sex offenses
- county of residence
- zip code

You may search by:

- person's name
- zip code

To view the CD ROM, you must:

- be 18 years of age or older
- provide a California Driver's License or I.D. card
- sign a statement that you understand the purpose of the release of information is for the public to protect themselves and their children from sex offenders; that it is illegal to use the information to harass, discriminate or commit a crime against any registrant
- state the distinct purpose for viewing the CD ROM, if required.

SEX OFFENDER IDENTIFICATION LINE

1-900-448-3000

Provides another means to obtain information of California's sex offenders.

To use the 900 line, you must be at least 18 years of age and you must know the following information about the person you are checking:

name of person AND one of the following:

- exact address, or
- exact date of birth, or
- California driver's license, identification number or social security number.

If you don't know the person's name, you will need to provide a complete description of the person.
