IMPORTANT INFORMATION

CIT volunteers must be a minimum of 14 years old or entering the ninth grade and a maximum of 16 years old

The CIT Volunteer Program gives teens the opportunity to work with children ages 5-12 at Camp Cypress Day Camp

CIT's must be available to volunteer Mon - Fri 8:30am - 4:30pm for four (4) weeks out of the ten (10) week program

CIT volunteers assist counselors with daily activities such as games, sports, excursions, arts & crafts and special classes

Interviews will be held in the middle of APRIL

A mandatory orientation will be scheduled for early JUNE

Schedules for volunteers will be given out at orientation
