IMPORTANT INFORMATION

CIT volunteers must be a minimum of 14 years old or entering the ninth grade and a maximum of 16 years old

The CIT Volunteer Program gives teens the opportunity to work with children ages 3-7 in the Pee Wee Sports Program and youth with disabilities in the Challenger Basketball Program

CIT's must be available to volunteer Tues. - Thurs, 9:15am - 12:15pm during the six (6) week Pee Wee Sports Program

CIT's must be available to volunteer Saturdays from 8:00am - 12:30pm during the six (6) week Challenger Basketball Program

Volunteers assist recreation leader with daily activities such as drills and exercises
